

Representation

Over the course of the last year the YPP has grown and is now a fully working partnership of agencies with a common aim - the betterment of services to young people. As it has grown, so too has interest from all sectors leading to a review of the YPP's membership arrangements.

In light of this, and with the new financial year approaching it seems to make sense to review the voluntary sectors arrangements for representation. Today we will look at our representatives and their roles and ensure that alternates are in place.

LHB Commissioning

During the second presentation, Sarah Williams will outline the new commissioning arrangements for the funding of voluntary sector organisations, through the LHB. Although the new arrangements will take time to implement, this holds particular relevance for organisations working with children and young people who would like more information on how to apply for funding from the LHB. Sarah will also be available to answer any questions at the end of the presentation.



Feedback

In the two weeks preceding this event (and in the two weeks following it) the Young People's Partnerships subgroups will be meeting to assess progress and look at next years delivery plan.
